My Body speaks: I think it is my God

An oratorio is a musical composition for voices and orchestra on a religious theme without costumes, scenery, or dramatic action. The Beat Movement and its activities were many and varied: proponents advocated experimentation in all forms – faith, food, sex, travel, art and work and through this formed their own strange orthodoxy. Dream Machine started off as a musical investigation of the lives of some of the Beat luminaries (William Burroughs, Allen Ginsberg and Brion Gysin) then it became something else. Fittingly, perhaps, and under the sway of the furious experimentation and playfulness the Beats were famous for, we began to experiment ourselves.

Could we create a musical without characters or plot?

Could we musically induce in the audience the emotions of these courageous, idiosyncratic and frustrated minds?

The Beats embodied a new kind of faith. Their belief in the benefits of multicultural synthesis, sexual tolerance, and resistance to commercial and societal conformity continue to permeate contemporary culture. If the Beats are a kind of religion, and an oratorio is a kind of love letter to religious feeling, then Dream Machine is our kind of oratorio – our billet-doux to this gang of notoriously wild outsiders who made our world better. Or if not better, they made it easier, just a little easier to be different.

WHAT IS A DREAM MACHINE?

The Dream Machine was a device that produced flickering light, invented by Brion Gysin and Ian Sommerville in 1960. The copy used in One Yellow Rabbit's production has been built according to Gysin and Sommerville's exact specifications. Their machine was meant to transport the user into a waking dream state. The inventors knew that it was capable of producing a drugless high, and hoped that it would become a common household appliance. It never caught on.






DYLAN BAUER


BLAKE BROOKER CM

DENISE CLARKE CM

Denise Clarke is a theatre artist who works as a choreographer, actor, director, playwright and teacher. She is the Associate Artist and a permanent member of the One Yellow Rabbit Theatre Ensemble and the director of the OYR BeautifulYoungArtist program.

Clarke was awarded the Lieutenant Governor of Alberta Distinguished Artist Award in 2007 and the City of Calgary Mayor's Distinguished Artist Award in 2011. She received an Honorary Doctorate from the University of Calgary and was appointed a member of the Order of Canada, both in 2013.



CHRIS CRAN RCA

Chris Cran is a Canadian visual artist living in Calgary. In 2016 he had a large survey exhibition (1984 – 2016) at the National Gallery of Canada in Ottawa that combined exhibitions from the Art Gallery of Alberta (2015) and the Southern Alberta Art Gallery (2015). More recently he has had exhibitions at the Glenbow Museum, the Nickle Art Galleries and the Whyte Museum in Banff. As well, he was awarded the Royal Canadian Geographical Society's Lawrence J. Burpee Medal in 2018. He is represented by Trépanier Baer Gallery in Calgary and Wilding Cran Gallery in Los Angeles.




ANDY CURTIS


NATALIE INGA GAUTHIER


MEREDITH JOHNSON


RALAMY KNEESHAW


JONATHAN LEWIS


ALLISON LYNCH
